voy · vas · va · vamos · vais · van

Example: I am going to upload a video → **Yo voy a subir un video.**

✓ Correct

Why?

| Yo va a publicar una foto. | Yo voy a publicar una foto. | IR must agree with the subject. Yo → voy, not va. |
| Ella publica las fotos en su perfil. | Ella publica las fotos en su perfil. | "Perfil" does not take a final -e. No change in plural forms needed here. |
| Nosotros chateamos todos días. | Nosotros chateamos todos los días. | In Spanish, "every day" requires the definite article: todos los días. |
| Voy a comentar en su publicación de ella. | Voy a comentar en su publicación. | The possessive "su" already shows ownership. Adding "de ella" is redundant in most contexts. |
